# New Business; The Rising Star Award

#### Sponsor

# Large Business of the Year Award (6+ Employees)

An outstanding business; an owner/operator storefront that, in the past year, has demonstrated outstanding overall business success and made achievements in the areas of business growth, employee development and community involvement. This award is presented to a business that has been in operation for two years or more with 6+ employees.

# Small Business of the Year Award (1-5 Employees)

An outstanding business; a home-based or owner/operator storefront that, in the past year, has demonstrated outstanding overall business success and made achievements in the areas of business growth, employee development and community involvement. This award is presented to a business that has been in operation for two years or more with less than 5 employees.

# **Hospitality & Tourism Award**

# Sponsor:

The Hospitality and Tourism Award recognizes businesses in the Clearwater and Wells Gray region that actively contribute to the development of the local hospitality and tourism industry while enhancing the overall visitor experience. The award emphasizes the importance of friendly, generous reception and, exemplary service and professionalism. The business or organization will have proven customer service and been in operation for a minimum of 2 years.

# **Trades & Service Excellence Award**

## Sponsor:

Recognizing a staff member or entrepreneur in a business or organization that, in the past year, has demonstrated dedication to their profession, trade or craft and proven themselves to be an asset to the business or community. This person actively seeks ways to enhance offerings to clients and customers and offers a unique value-added proposition and consistently demonstrates leadership in their area of expertise.
